History

The Cartier family, descendant of the famous Jacques Cartier who discovered Canada, lived in Couronneau during more than three centuries, and was buried there. With them, started the new start of this austere Castle by becoming a large wine producer since the XVIth century. Christophe, after a start as a négociant decided not only to become a winemaker, but to do it organically.

The top value of the domaine

Everything is made for quality; the work in the vineyards, the new plantations, the weed planting, the selection, the high trim, the work on leaves to optimize maturity, the low yield to get a natural concentration: an « Haute Couture » vinification.

A few woods

Organically certified since 2000, many medals and top tasting notes. The concentration is rich, powerful but natural. He gets it because of the work done in the vineyards and the meticulous control of the harvest.
